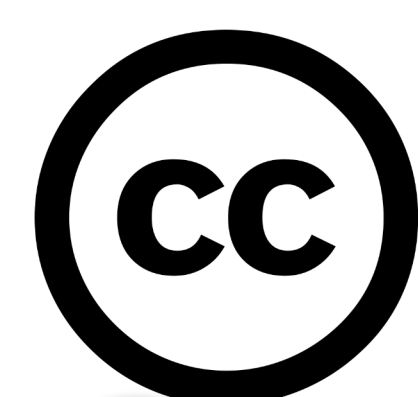


OUR WEEK IN SLOVAKIA
